

2025 TUT FULL-TIME STUDY POSTGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIPS

The Tshwane University of Technology is pleased to announce that full-time TUT master's and Doctoral scholarships are available to eligible postgraduate students for 2025. Candidates pursuing their studies or research in areas such as social and human sciences, economic and management sciences, natural and applied sciences as well as engineering and technology may apply (OPEN FOR ALL DISCIPLINES).

Eligibility

- Only available to eligible full-time students, and South African citizens who qualify.
- International students must have obtained 70% and above for their previous qualifications to qualify for a scholarship.
- Students must have obtained a minimum average of 65% in their previous studies to gualify for a scholarship (in deserving cases, the FCRI may motivate for South African students who obtained an average of 60%-64% to receive scholarships).
- All students who received first-year funding from TUT, are encouraged to apply for external scholarships for the second and third year of their studies.
- Must comply with the in-house faculty criteria, where applicable.
- Not intended for a second master's or Doctoral degrees, or for students doing their third year of master's or fourth year of doctoral studies.
- Students who receive Government scholarships (e.g., MRC, Mandela-Rhodes, TUT-CSIR) only qualify for a top-up as stipulated in the agreement from the external funder.
- Evidence of financial assistance towards studies (Applicable to international students).

Faculties and departments may top up non-governmental scholarships with FCRI or DCRI funding, but the amount should not exceed R200 000 per annum (top-up can range from R10 000 to a maximum of R20 000 per student per annum). Students who are employed but earning less than R400 000 can apply and if eligible, the below sliding scale will apply.

Master's Degree - R80 000 per annum (tuition fees included) Doctoral Degree - R100 000 per annum (tuition fees excluded)
